May 2

Concluding the story of Esther, this teaching illustrates how God protects His people from evil plots,

just as He did with Haman's scheme against the Jews. However, it also emphasizes that believers must sometimes bravely stand up to defend themselves and their families rather than just accepting abuse.

May 10

This special Mother's Day message draws on biblical examples like Hannah, Ruth, and Sarah to teach the importance of honoring the women who raised us.



It reminds believers of the biblical promise connected to respecting our parents and that even great biblical figures made mistakes and needed God's grace.



May 17

By analyzing the mentor-protege relationships of Moses with Joshua and Elijah with Elisha, this message teaches how to faithfully serve under tough leaders.

It emphasizes the necessity of completing tasks, having a resilient hard skin against offenses, and remaining obedient to prepare for your own calling.

May 24

Based on Jesus dining with tax collectors, this teaching uses the resilient palm tree to illustrate how Christians should interact with the world.



Believers must be flexible enough to spend time with ungodly people without judging them, while remaining firmly planted in clean, godly behavior.



May 31

Dr. Gian explains that Jesus's anointing is meant to set people free from both moral and financial poverty.

The message offers practical steps for true abundance, such as gaining biblical wisdom, maintaining a positive attitude, and practicing good stewardship with what you already have.

June 6

True happiness is not found in material things or other people, but in knowing God intimately.



This message explains that acquiring biblical wisdom, maintaining a continuous prayer life, and joyfully accepting God's will are the true secrets to lasting joy.

June 13

Highlighting the vital importance of balanced communication, this message urges believers to stay calm and control their words.

It teaches that you can overcome life's challenges by continually repeating and declaring God's biblical promises in faith.

June 21

Using the metaphor of an eagle learning to fly, this message inspires believers to discover their true identity in God.



It highlights the process of renewing your mind with the Word, stepping out in faith despite your fears, and developing personal leadership.



Jun 28

Dr. Gian compares feeling lost in life to a broken GPS caused by a lack of discipline and fear of God.

By returning to daily habits like praying, reading, writing, speaking, singing, and repenting, you allow God to Provide the Solution (GPS) and restore your direction.

BIBLE STUDY

May 6

Examining the first part of the Lord's Prayer, this study teaches that the primary intention of our prayers must be honoring God.



It stresses the importance of submitting to God the Father's authority and prioritizing His will above our own desires.

This study focuses on our human weakness against temptation and our absolute need to depend on the Holy Spirit.

It warns believers to be intelligent and avoid places where the evil one operates through lies, deception, and manipulation.

June 3

This episode warns that unforgiveness and bitterness act like a spiritual cancer in believers. Christians are challenged to drop the charges against those who offend them, let the offense go, wish them well, and praise God.
